Rudi has very interesting contacts with Bratz and Braatz in Chile. Here is his description.

This family came first to Brazil (Blumenau), then, desperate with snakes, spiders, onças (like pumas) and mosquitoes, they sent a member to Chile to prospect for a more adequate site to live. He came back and told that he saw and touched snow, real snow. That was decisive for them to decide to move to Chile. They got some land here from government, but it was very poor. Therefore they moved to other parts of Chile. This family came to Pucon, near the Villarrica volcano.
